Project: Skills Support for the Unemployed

Location: Cambridgeshire

Job Outcome: Secured Temporary Employment at Ridgeons

Anthony Humphrey was referred onto the Cambridgeshire Pilot Project, which is funded by the Skills Funding Agency and managed by TCHC, by his local Jobcentre Plus. He was unemployed and claiming benefits and needed a project which would develop his skills and experience and increase his chances of getting a job.

The project began with an Information, Advice and Guidance session where he discussed his options with an experienced TCHC adviser and set career goals for the future. He then attended an Employability Skills Session where he learned about writing effective CVs and covering letters.

During this project he learned about applying for work and was made aware of the numerous opportunities out there for his career development. He continued to receive support from TCHC, with emails and phone calls to find out how his job search is going and to give him further advice.

The project has made a difference to him personally because he has managed to get back into work on a temporary basis as a sales consultant at Ridgeons, and has since been offered the opportunity to apply for a full-time role in the company. This would not have been possible without the skills and confidence he has developed as a result of the project offered by TCHC.
